Following the defendants recent request whilst you were away on vacation last week to have the hearing of my application for summary judgement adjourned for a second time, and in addition to my recent application to commence with proceedings against the defendant for contempt of court, I would now like to respectfully bring to your attention the fact that I feel that the defendants solicitors may unnecessarily be wasting the courts time with regards to the proceedings of the above case.

In a voicemail message left by the defendants solicitor on Thursday 1st June 2006 I was surprisingly informed that the next hearing for the summary judgement applications will be before Master Turner and will be listed for some time in late July or early August. They have also since suggested by means of a letter that before contacting the court to arrange the agreed date for the hearing I should contact them first so that 'the service of any evidence in response to their summary judgment application can be agreed'. They have also indicated that the alleged evidence that is to support their recent summary judgment application will not be attached with their application notice but that it will be forwarded to me "in due course".

Having spoken with Master Turner on Friday afternoon it appears that at the time of making the request that today's hearing be vacated, the defendants solicitor actually failed to mention the fact that you had already adjourned today's hearing once before because the defendant did not turn up on the 3rd May 2006.

I understand from the court office that the defendant submitted their application for summary judgment to the court on Wednesday 31st May 2006. Given the fact that the defendant had told the court that they had been unable to contact me to seek my consent, I would like to confirm that the defendants solicitor did not actually contact me regarding this request until Thursday 1st June 2006.

Please be advised that the only reason that I did not offer my consent to have today's hearing vacated was simply because I feel that the defendants solicitors are attempting to unnecessarily delay the proceedings.
